Before migration, birds (like the blackpoll warbler) double their weight so they can fuel the journey.





HOW TO FOLD THE FORTUNE TELLER




1) Fold the four corners of the square into the middle.

2) You now have a smaller square.




3) Turn this smaller square over.



4) Fold the four corners in a second time.



5) The points of all four corners now meet in the middle.



6) Fold in half.



7) Open the corners out so your fingers go into the pockets of paper in each of the four corners.
